



Didier Jutras-Aswad is an Addiction Psychiatrist and Chief of the Department of Psychiatry at the Centre hospitalier de l'Université de Montréal (CHUM), and Professor of Psychiatry and Addictology at the Université de Montréal. He is President of the UdeM Expertise and Collaboration Centre on Concurrent Disorders and Principal Scientist at the CHUM Research Centre. His research focuses on substance use and concurrent mental health disorders, combining clinical and translational approaches to develop and evaluate innovative interventions and models of care. He has authored or co-authored 200+ publications, leads multiple multisite national clinical trials in the field of substance use disorders in Canada, and plays leadership roles in national and international research and policy initiatives, including as a Principal Investigator with the Canadian Research Initiative in Substance Misuse (CRISM), as a member of the Board of Directors of the Mental Health Commission of Canada, and through active international research collaborations.
