

Zsolt Demetrovics is a Matthew Flinders Professor in Mental Health and Wellbeing at the College of Human Sciences and Culture at Flinders University (Adelaide, Australia), where he also serves as Director of the Flinders University Institute for Mental Health and Wellbeing (FIMHWell) and Dean (Research) of the College. He also leads the Addiction Research Group at the ELTE Eötvös Loránd University (Budapest, Hungary). Zsolt has published over 600 papers and book chapters on the epidemiology, assessment, and psychological correlates of substance use behaviour and behavioural addictions, including gambling, video game use, internet addiction, problematic social media use, hypersexual behaviour, exercise addiction, work addiction, and compulsive buying. He is president of the *International Society for the Study of Behavioral Addictions* and founding Editor-in-Chief of the *Journal of Behavioral Addictions*
